

Over the next two years, North Shore Water Reclamation District will be replacing 59 Rockwell Automation PLC-5 processors with modern ControlLogix processors and I/O devices. The replacements are necessary to repair aging equipment and to ensure the continued reliable processing of wastewater at our three water reclamation facilities in Lake County. These replacements are being financed by the Clean Water State Revolving Fund (SRF). The SRF program is administered by the Illinois Environmental Protection Agency and receives a portion of its money to fund these types of projects from the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. SRF programs operate in each state to provide communities the resources necessary to build, maintain, and improve the infrastructure that protects one of our most valuable resources: water.
